Expanded Recycling Program

The City of Valparaiso has developed an expanded recyclable material collection system. Our recycling program decreases the waste stream currently going to a landfill by offering an alternative means of disposal. We have constructed a holding area which is used to collect, bale, and prepare materials for transport to a recycling center. Currently, we have two drop off points for recyclable materials, as listed below, for residents and non-residents. There is no increased cost associated with this service.

Please place items in designated bins.

Acceptable Materials:

1. Cardboard- Corrugated Cardboard or Boxboard (cereal box)
2. White office paper
3. Mixed paper/newspaper
4. Plastics- #1 (PET or PETE) and #2 (HDPE)
5. Aluminum cans, which will continue to be donated to the fireworks fund

Due to the current market it is not cost effective to recycle glass containers at this time.
